# Immigration Facts

Here are some facts about Illegal Aliens. Whether a person agrees or disagrees with the Arizona Law, it cannot be denied that these numbers are diluting the very fabric of what America is and should be. It is appalling that the "left" demonizes the "right" calling us racists, bigots and worse.

We must stick to American values, enforce our laws, and make people come in the right way. They should feel honor, not shame, for being in America. ## The Facts:

- 62% of all “illegal aliens” in the United States are working for cash and not paying taxes.
- More than 380,000 “anchor babies” born in the United States in 2005 were to parents who are illegal aliens; making those 380,000 babies automatically U.S. citizens. 97.2% of all costs incurred from those births were paid by the American taxpayer.
- More than half of all gang members in Los Angeles are illegal aliens from south of the border.
- More than 43% of all Food Stamps issued are to illegal aliens.
- 58% of all welfare payments in the United States are issued to illegal aliens.
- Nearly 60% of all occupants of HUD properties in the United States are illegal aliens.
- 29% (630,000) of the inmates in all state and federal prisons are illegal aliens—at a cost of \$1.6 billion annually.
- Warrant for murder: 95% in Los Angeles ,83% in Phoenix, 86% in Albuquerque are for illegal aliens.
- More than 53% of all investigated burglaries reported in California, New Mexico, Nevada, Arizona, and Texas are perpetrated by illegal aliens
- 40.1% of all inmates in Arizona detention centers are Mexican nationals here illegally.

The killings in Arizona will not stop in Arizona. They will spread from state to state as drug cartels continue their push northward. Our borders must be fenced and closed. Our laws must be enforced. There can be no sanctuary cities.

**MASSACHUSETTS COMES ON BOARD!!**

At the end of May, 2010, the Massachusetts State Senate passed an immigration enforcement amendment, 28-to-10, to an appropriation bill. The State House had previously passed a different version of the spending bill, so the enforcement amendment is at the mercy of a conference committee.

The amendment would require companies doing business with the state to verify their new hires through E-Verify, the employment verification tool administered by the Department of Homeland Security. The amendment also would deny illegal aliens access to in-state tuition rates and require proof of citizenship before receiving welfare services. It also places a stiff penalty -- up to 15 years in prison and \$10,000 fine -- if an illegal alien is caught using a stolen identity when applying for a job with a state contractor.

"This sends a very strong message," Senate Republican leader Richard Tisei said. "You shouldn't be here illegally if you want to access benefits."

Just before the vote, Suffolk University and Boston television station WHDH released poll results revealing that 84% of Commonwealth residents supported citizenship verification before receiving public benefits.

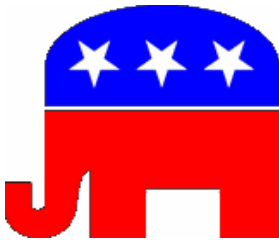
